Music and Bamboo by Flute Jayant & Band

J.A. Jayant possesses a distinctive virtuoso fingering and flute-blowing technique that enables him to beautifully present his music, even in the challenging lower octaves on the bass and double-bass thick-walled bamboo flutes. He maintains perfect pitching (shruthi suddham) and supreme tonal quality. His expressive and graceful rendering, filled with emotion (bhaava-laden), skillfully brings out the depth and soul of lyrical aspects in compositions, following the gaavaki-form. This approach consistently earns him lasting appreciation from various quarters, including senior musicians, co-artists, connoisseurs, and music lovers (rasikas). Jayant has garnered numerous awards and recognitions, including the Kalki Krishnamurthy Memorial Award for 2018, the Best Instrumentalist Award seven times from The Madras Music Academy, and The Bharat Ratna Dr. M. S. Subbalakshmi Fellowship from Sri Shanmukhananda Sabha — Mumbai.
